



## GREATER NEW YORK AL-ANON FAMILY INTERGROUP FACT SHEET

### What is Intergroup?

The Greater New York Al-Anon Family Intergroup, Inc., (“Intergroup”) is New York City’s Al-Anon information center.

### What does Intergroup do?

Intergroup provides **vital services** to New Yorkers in the five boroughs of New York who are affected by the family disease of alcoholism.

### These services are

1. Provides phone contact. The Intergroup phone line is often the first contact for those seeking help from Al-Anon in the NYC area.
2. Intergroup maintains an up-to-date listing of all Al-Anon meetings in New York City.
3. Provides info about Al-Anon on line and by phone.
4. Coordinates Alateen, public outreach and speaker referrals to prisons, hospitals, schools, and treatment centers.
5. Sells Conference-approved literature.
6. Coordinates communication between all of the different meetings in NYC through its system of Intergroup Representatives (“IRs”).
7. Brings together members through Share-A-Days, dances and other activities.
8. Provides the ability to do Al-Anon service above the group level.
